Transitioning To A New Email Comes With Benefits

When telecommunication companies first began providing dial-up internet to customers in the late 90s, thirty years ago, the internet service came with email.

During that same time, tech companies Microsoft, Yahoo, and Google emerged. These companies were not only working on their initial service offerings of computer software, web directories, and search engines; they soon developed email platforms.

Today—Google, Microsoft, and Yahoo are leading providers of free email (Gmail, Outlook, Yahoo) globally! With users in the millions, even billions! They've reached the top because of their user-friendly interface, superior spam filtering, large storage capacity, and the ability for their email to be used with their other applications, such as Microsoft Office (Outlook, Word, Excel, Powerpoint, and Publisher) and Google Workspace (Gmail, Docs, Sheets, Slides, and Forms)—software applications many of us use with phones, laptops and computers everyday.

With superior email options available and the time and costs associated with tnics email... we announced in January, RC would be retiring its tnics email toward the end of 2024. Doing so allows those resources to be redirected toward our primary focus, the internet, where they would be better served.

SETTING UP A NEW EMAIL ADDRESS

Before choosing which email provider to use, ask family and friends what email service provider they're using. This will give you comfort that someone you know is using the same email you are and will be beneficial in getting assistance from family or friends.

You <u>may already have</u> a *Gmail* or *iCloud* (Apple) email you set up that you haven't been using. It may have been set up with a new cell phone, computer, or other device. <u>To check to see if you already have a Gmail account follow these steps.</u>

1.) Find the Google app icon on your smartphone or computer and click on it. 2.) Once opened look at the top upper right hand corner of your phone or computer screen. You may see your first initial in a circle, if so, click the circle. 3.) There you'll see the address, if you do.



MINE, YOURS, AND OURS

If you have previously shared a tnics email with a spouse or the household and you'd still like to create a household email, please create your own individual email for personal stuff for things like credit cards that are just your name, etc. More companies are adding *Multi-Factor Authetication* codes as an additional layer of security for log-ins to accounts/sites. These codes are only accessible to that particular individual by email or cell number to protect you, making it difficult to receive a code, if the person/device is not present.
